Snacks are not provided before clubs. If children wish to bring a healthy snack from home, this can be eaten at the end of the school day before club.

School uniform

Could we ask you to ensure that <u>all items</u> of school uniform are named. It is very difficult to locate lost clothing when it is unnamed or when names have washed out.

Please could you also ensure that the children are wearing the correct uniform every day and only come to school in trainers on PE days (Monday and Thursday).

<u>Coats</u>- Children still need to have a waterproof coat in school every day as they will be going outside for fresh air and to release their abundant energy, even when there are showers.

<u>Water bottles</u>- please ensure that the children bring in a water bottle every day- this will be increasingly important as the weather becomes warmer. The children must have water in their water bottles, not juice (clear flavoured water is allowed). They can bring an extra drink of juice or milk for lunch.

<u>Jewellery</u>- please do not allow the children to come into school wearing any jewellery, except for a simple watch and plain studs if they have pierced ears. These should be removed on PE days if at all possible. Jewellery will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day.

<u>Pre-loved uniform</u>- We have lots of pre-loved uniform available, especially in smaller sizes. Why pay for new when we can re-use? Please send your requirements into the school office or pop a message on Facebook and we can send clothes home with your child. Cost- only 50p per item payable at the school office please.

Other news

<u>Toys</u>- please do not send in toys from home (unless a sensory or transition toy has been discussed with the teacher, SENCo or Head of School as support for a specific need.)

<u>Home2School</u>- If children are at Home2school club after 3.45 please can they bring in a healthy snack. They should not bring toys from home as these can get lost and there are plenty of activities for them to access in school. Hopefully, as the weather gets warmer (and hopefully drier), they will also have the opportunity to play outside too.
