I hope you are all keeping well and being very good.

I hope that you are managing to do some of the work from the website, there is a lot to choose from now. I hope you are trying to do some maths and English each week as well as choosing science and other activities. You can go back and try activities from other weeks that you didn't have time to do.

This week, I have put on the links to the next 10 maths lessons from NCETM, they are very good and will keep you busy for the next two weeks. I hope you have been following them and trying the activities. You will all be very good at multiplication and division if you have!

For EYFS, I have put some number stories to help you to think carefully about number bonds to ten.

In school, we are looking at the story of Peter Rabbit this week, I have put the power-point on the website for you so that you can try some of the activities that we will be doing. There are also some episodes of the story on CBeebies that you can watch.

There's some single letter sound practise that will help you with your letter formation, and help you to recap the phonic sounds, as well as practise reading some words with each letter in. These will be good for EYFS and Y1, and revision for year 2 who find cursive formation tricky.

Finally, I have included a Year 1 and a Year 2 Activity Booklet. These have lots of maths and English activities in, enough for a page of maths and a page of English everyday for the next four weeks! Don't try to print them all out, use the maths and English exercise books that you were given in your packs at the start of lockdown and write the page number and answers to the activities in there. Ask your parents or carers to help you read the questions but see if you can answer them on your own. This will be a good check of what you can remember. (If you need another maths/English book let me know and I will leave them out with the hampers on Wednesday (mandy.lill@partney.lincs.sch.uk)).
